COVERAGE PERIOD

Coverage starts on the day specified on your declaration page and continues through the elected time shown. Payment must be received within 14 days of closing. Unless renewed prior to the date listed on your declaration page is the date the membership is expired, therefore no service requests will be accepted on that day.

(A)If a home inspection was not performed on the residence prior to purchase, coverage will be 30 days after the start date on the declaration page.
(B) TO WAIVE THE INITIAL 30-DAY WAITING PERIOD, YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR INSPECTION REPORT TO CRAST.THIS REPORT MUST SHOW THAT THE ITEMS INCLUDED IN YOUR COVERAGE WERE INSPECTED AND ARE IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION, WITH NO FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS, INSPECTIONS OR REPAIRS BY A TECHNICIAN SUGGESTED FOR COVERAGE TO APPLY. NO PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

(C) In the event a claim is filed within the first 30 days of coverage, the maximum payout will be \$150.00 on covered items. After this period, normal limits will apply.

BUILT-IN MICROWAVE

COVERED: All Components and Parts, except:

For HVAC Systems 5 years or older, CRAST will use a Guide for a Prorated amount based on Age. This will be based on units comparable to existing units that are currently in the home during this membership term.

AIR CONDITIONING/COOLER

Limited to two units. Main source of Air Conditioning to the home, up to a 5 (five) ton capacity, Electric Units below 21 SEER, and designed for Residential use. Coverage applies to ducted units only.

When Freon (R-22) is phased out, it will be the Member's responsibility to upgrade all equipment to Federal or State code to be covered. At this point, CRAST will only include coverage for equipment which utilizes environmentally friendly refrigerant. Examples R-410A and/or R438A (ISCEON MO99), etc. NOTE: Standard Thermostat shall not exceed cost of \$80.00. Limited to one thermostat per Membership term.

NOTE: CRAST will provide access to Plumbing Systems through Unobstructed Walls, Ceilings, or Floors, only, and will return the access opening to rough finish condition up to \$250.00 which will deduct from Plumbing Limit. CRAST shall not be responsible for payment of the cost to remove and replace any Built-In Appliances, Cabinets, Floor Coverings, or other Obstructions impeding access to Walls, Ceilings, and/or Floors.

NOTE: CRAST will pay up to \$500.00 per Membership Term.

1. How do I make a service request?

Typically, any issues found in the home inspection report should be addressed by the seller prior to closing. Known pre-existing conditions that show up on your home inspection report will not be covered by AFC or any company in the home warranty industry.

When you have repairs done prior to closing, hold on to any proof-of-repair invoices. These invoices help AFC confirm that your home had no pre-existing issues when your membership started.
